BY-LAW NO. 3058-78

A BY-LAW FOR THE REGULATION OF OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1970, Section 354 (27) authorizes municipalities to prescribe for the whole or any part of the municipality the times during which fires may be set in the open air, and the precautions to be observed by persons setting out fires.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF ARNPRIOR:

1. No person shall kindle a fire in any yard or alley for the purpose of burning any wood, straw, paper, shavings or refuse unless a permit has been obtained from the Fire Chief of the Town of Arnprior.
2. Every person authorized to have an open fire shall comply with the following conditions:
 - a) all fires shall be contained within an open pit or steel container, protected with a spark arrestor.
 - b) no fire shall be set within twenty-five feet of any building, fence, or other combustible material.
 - c) an adult shall be in attendance at all times until the fire is extinguished, burning shall not commence until one half hour after sunrise and cease one half hour before sunset.
3. Any person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable for a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not exceeding \$50.00 exclusive of costs or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 21 days or to both fine and imprisonment.
4. This by-law shall take effect upon the day of the official passing thereof.
