Please read and fully understand the below waiver before signing.

Helmets are strongly recommended for all users. They can be rented at the ski hill.

Terrain Parks will not be open for any youth during the duration of the Ski Club. Parents are not entitled to sign permission forms to allow their child into a terrain park at any time. Should a youth go into a terrain park, they themselves and their family is responsible for any injuries or accidents that may happen in this park. They will lose their lift pass for the day and have to remain in the ski lodge with an adult volunteer until bus departure.

*Please note that this is a club that allows youth to visit Mont Cascades Ski Hill by offering discounted rates and transportation to and from the ski hill. There are no programs available on the hill through the Parks and Rec Department during trip hours. The bus picks up youth in Arnprior at the 8:30am at the Nick Smith Centre, and leaves the ski hill at 4:00pm, returning to the Nick Smith Centre at approximately 5:30pm. Youth are responsible for ensuring that they attend their lesson on time, return rentals, and board the bus at the designated times. **We are not responsible for skiing or snowboarding with your child.** We strongly recommend the buddy rule, in which there are at least two skiers/snowboarders together on the hill and lodge. Each participant must check in with the adult at the lodge between 11:30 and 1:30pm.*

There is a strict no alcohol or drug, including drug paraphernalia rule. Should this be an issue, local police will be called and parents are responsible for the youth's transportation back. The youth will not be allowed to participate in any other bus trips offered by Arnprior Parks and Recreation.

*Youth that do not follow ski hills rules and regulations or are causing problems on the bus to and from the event will not be allowed to ski or snowboard that day, or any other trip. **Payment will not be refunded to parents for misbehaviour.***

I understand that this particular activity is a dangerous activity and can cause injury, paralysis or death. I understand that there are particular risks involved in this activity that is beyond the control of the Ski Hill, Arnprior Parks and Recreation, Renfrew County Bus Lines, and all supervisors, chaperones, volunteers and employees of the above are not responsible for the actions that may result in injury paralysis or death in my child. I have read and understood the rules and dangers of the trip and I have discussed these with my child.

Should my child need any type of medical attention, whether it be urgent or non, then I allow any necessary medical procedures to be followed through by ski patrol, paramedics, trained professionals, employees or supervisors.

I, the undersigned, do hereby release and agree to indemnify and save harmless Arnprior Parks and Recreation Department, The Corporation of The Town of Arnprior, Renfrew County Bus Lines, Mont Cascades, and their respective officers, volunteers, employees, or agents and each and every Board and Commission thereof, from all claims for loss, injury or damage, to persons and property while participating in or traveling to and from the above activity, which I, or any person claiming through me or on my behalf, may at any time have arising out of or connected with the operations of this activity.
